INTRODUCTION

- The 7th Combined Policy Meeting on Admissions was held on Thursday, 2nd June, 2016 at the NUC.
- The Honourable Minister of Education directed the immediate stoppage of Post UTME TEST by ALL tertiary institutions.
- The Honourable Minister further directed that a meeting of all stakeholders should be convened.

- This is to work out the modalities for screening of candidates duly recommended for admissions.
- In view of the National importance of this meeting, the Permanent Secretary, Federal Ministry of Education is here to chair the meeting.
- This is to ensure that the Honourable Minister's directives are strictly adhered to.

2015/2016 ADMISSION SCREENING GUIDELINES FOR THE UNIVERSITY AND ITS AFFILIATED INSTITUTIONS

The following guidelines are to be strictly adhered to during the Screening Exercise and on no account should any faculty/institutions compromise the guidelines provided, please.

A. UTME Candidates:

- 1. Candidates admitted must have at least have 5 O/Level Credits including English and Mathematics and other relevant subjects (Refer to Departmental requirements)*
- 2. The O/Level results(WAEC, NECO and NABTEB) For UTME candidates to be considered for admission must not exceed five years (i.e.2010-2015)*
- 3. Only computer printed results shall be considered for screening which should be authenticated on the Examination body website.*
- 4. Candidates to bring along Scratch Cards of relevant O/Level results for on-line verification.*
- 5. Minimum cut-off point for admission of UTME candidates is 180; therefore only candidates with 180 and above points shall be screened.*
- 6. A maximum of two sittings is allowed in case of O/Level requirement.*

B. DE Candidates

- 1. PRE-Diploma and Pre-NCE results are not acceptable in place of O/Level credits.*
- 2. DE candidates with a pass in NCE must have taught for a period of five years before qualifying for Degree program*
- 3. Only Diplomas from recognized polytechnics can be accepted for the purpose of DE admissions.*

4. *All UMB candidates must satisfy the 5 o/level credits in addition to obtaining at least 6 points.*
5. *UMB points are counted on the basis of letter grade as follows A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2 and E= 1 plus 1 point bonus for passing the 3 subjects.*
6. *Candidates with Awaiting Results are not eligible for admission as well as screening.*

C. General rule

1. *Candidates must provide Letter of invitation for the screening downloaded from the University website.*
2. *Candidates must provide evidence of payment of screening charges.*

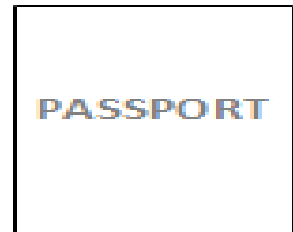
