ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS
The following constitute the minimum entry requirements into the postgraduate programmes:
All applicants seeking admission into any of the Masters Degree and Postgraduate Diploma programmes must have five Credit passes at 'O' Level in relevant subjects including English Language and Mathematics at not more than two sittings.

1. POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME
A graduate from a recognized University with Third Class at the first degree in relevant programme may be admitted, provided the Matriculation and Departmental requirements of Ekiti State University are satisfied. A holder of a minimum of Upper Credit in the HND from a recognized institution may also be admitted. For applicants possessing Postgraduate Diploma (PGD), a minimum of Credit or 60.0 weighted average score is required.

2. MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMME
a. A candidate with a first degree from a recognized University having a minimum of a Second Class Lower Division may be admitted, provided the University Matriculation and Departmental requirements are satisfied.
b. A candidate with a minimum of Credit 3.5 on a relative score of 5.0 i.e a weighted average score of 60.0 in the Postgraduate Diploma from a recognized University may also be admitted.

3. LL.M. IN LAW
a. LL.B. degree awarded by Ekiti State University or any other recognized University with a minimum of Second Class (Honours) Lower Division.
b. A minimum of five (5) Credit Passes, including English Language and Literature in English at not more than two (2) sittings in SSCE/GCE Ordinary Level or its equivalent.

4. M.PHIL/PH.D IN LAW
LL.M. with Long Essay with a minimum weighted average score of not less than 55.

5. M.PHIL/PH.D IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION
Candidates must possess M.Sc in Business Administration with specialization in Management, Marketing, Organizational Behaviour or Operations Research with weighted average of 50 – 59.

6. DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY (Ph.D) DEGREE
a. A candidate with a good Masters degree weighted average of not below 60.0 or CGPA of 3.5 on a relative score of 5.0 (NOT Professional Masters) in the relevant or related discipline which includes course work and a defended research dissertation from a recognized University may be admitted, provided the University Matriculation and Departmental requirements are satisfied.
b. A minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.50 or 60.0 weighted average score is required for candidates converting from M.Phil to Ph.D.
c. In addition to these admission requirements, candidates may be required to present themselves for selection test and or interview at both Masters, M.Phil/Ph.D Programmes.

CREDENTIALS
Photocopies of NYSC Discharge/Exemption/Exclusion

Certificate, photocopies of all credentials, including 'O' level or its equivalents must be attached to the completed application forms. Candidates must as well arrange for their transcripts to be sent directly to the Secretary, College of Postgraduate Studies. **Non-Receipt of academic transcripts in time is at the detriment of the applicant.**

DURATION OF PROGRAMMES
Postgraduate Diploma Programmes
a. Full-Time Diploma: Minimum of two semesters and a maximum of four semesters.
b. Part-Time Diploma: Minimum of four semesters and a maximum of six semesters.

Masters Degree Programmes
a. Full-Time: A minimum of four (4) semesters and a maximum of six (6) semesters
b. Part-Time: A minimum of six (6) semesters and a maximum of eight (8) semesters.

Ph.D Programme
a. Full-Time: A minimum of six (6) semesters and a maximum of ten (10) semesters
b. Part-Time: A minimum of eight (8) semesters and a maximum of twelve (12) semesters.
