Admission Requirements:

- **A.** Candidates for Master's degree in the Institute of Education shall possess a minimum of Second Class Lower Division in the relevant field of study, or PGDE/PGDTE obtained from Rivers State University or any other recognized Institution of higher learning of equivalent status.
- i. Candidates for Post graduate Diploma in Institute of Education shall possess first degree not less than a third class awarded by any recognized Institution/University.
- ii. Higher National Diploma (HND) not less than lower credit or its equivalent in any subject discipline or its equivalent in any Technical subject/disciple(for PGDTE only), awarded by any recognized institution
- iii. Candidates for Doctor of Philosophy Degree in the Institute of Education shall possess a Masters Degree relevant field of study, obtained from Rivers State University or any other recognized Institution of higher learning of equivalent status.
- **B.** Candidates for PhD Full time/part time in Law and Diplomacy should possess any of the following:-
- (a) Master of Laws Degree (LLM), or
- (b) Master of Arts in Law and Diplomacy (MALD) or
- (c) Master of Law and Diplomacy (MLD) or
- (d) Master of International Law and Diplomacy (MILD) or
- (e) Any other Advanced Masters Degree in Law or its equivalent that is awarded by recognised Faculties established in Nigerian Universities or Universities abroad.
- C. Candidates for Post Graduate Diploma in Political Science shall be Holders of at least a Third Class Degree in the subject area applied for or a Second Class (Lower Division) Degree in a related discipline obtained from the Rivers State University or any other recognized institution of equivalent status;
 - (i) Candidate for Masters Degree in Political Science must possess a minimum of Second Class Lower Degree in Political Science obtained from the Rivers State University or any other recognized institution of equivalent status;
 - (ii) Candidate with a PGD in Political Science and related field from a recognized institution with a CGPA of at least 3.50 on a five-point scales.

Candidate for PhD Degree in Political Science must possess a Master's Degree in Political Science and related field with a CGPS of at least 3.50 on a 5.0-points scale.

NOTE:

Applicant with the qualifications in the above disciplines shall be eligible for admission into the postgraduate programmes; however, candidates must fulfill the matriculation requirements of the Rivers State University, Nkpolu-Oroworukwo, Port Harcourt as stated below:-

All candidates must possess the minimum of five ordinary level credit passes which must include English Language and mathematics.

DURATION:

A. Post Graduate Programme (PGD)

- i. The PGD programme in the Institute of Education shall run for a minimum of one Sandwich year
- ii. The PGD programme shall run for a minimum of two (2) semesters and a maximum of (4) semesters

B. Master of Science (Msc)

- i. A full-time Mater's programme shall run for a minimum of four (4) semesters and a maximum of six (6) semesters.
- ii. Mater's programme in the Institute of Education shall run for a minimum of two (2) Sandwich years.

C. Doctor of Philosophy

A PhD programme shall run for a minimum of six (6) semesters and a maximum (8)

A PhD programme in the Institute of Education shall run for a minimum of three (3). Sandwich years.

PhD Part time programme: run for a minimum of eight (8) semesters and a maximum of tens (10) semesters.

MODE OF APPLICATION

Applications for admission to any Sandwich Postgraduate programme shall be made on-line by logging onto www.ust.edu.ng and making e-payment of Twenty Thousand Naira (\$\frac{1}{2}2,000.00) only, using inter-switch verve enabled cards.

Application forms should be completed on-line, downloaded and hard copies submitted to the secretary, Institute of Education, accompanied by photocopies of relevant credentials and proof of payment.

- ii) Certified academic transcripts. (It is the responsibility of applicants to ensure that copies of their academic transcripts are forwarded under confidential cover directly to The Secretary, Postgraduate School, Rivers State University, Nkpolu-Oroworukwo, Port Harcourt).
- iii) Letter of reference from three referees, including one from a previous academic institution, stating that applicant is qualified to undertake advanced studies and research and that the Referee is confident that the applicant will benefit from the training.

For PhD applicants, brief research proposals on their intended areas of study should also accompany the application forms.
