2.2.01 BENSON IDAHOSA UNIVERSITY

- (a) Regulations governing admissions into First Degree programmes in Benson Idahosa University are as follows:

2.2.03 UNIVERSITY OF LAGOS, LAGOS

- (i) University of Lagos requires all candidates applying for admissions into any of its programmes to possess at least five (5) SSC Credit passes in relevant subjects at one sitting including Mathematics and English Language.

(ii) DIRECT ENTRY ADMISSION

- (a) Accepts National Diploma plus UTME requirements for all Direct Entry Admissions.
- (b) holders of first degree who have completed NYSC programme with first class/second class upper may be accepted for Law or Medical Science programmes. Candidates must have the UTME requirements.
- i. Literature in English Language is not a requirement for graduate candidates seeking direct admission into the Faculty of Law.
 - ii. For admissions into Medicine and Surgery, only degrees in relevant fields will be accepted.
- (c) Two (2) or three (3) 'A' Level passes which must be at a minimum of grade 'C' in addition to the UTME requirements.
- (d) The following 2/3-year Diploma/Certificate are acceptable provided the candidates have the UTME requirements.

 - iii. Two (2)-year ND at Distinction level in Music or Theatre Arts for Creative Arts.

- iv. HND/ND at Distinction level for candidates seeking admissions into the relevant programmes in the Faculties of Engineering and Environmental Sciences.
- v. NCE in relevant subjects at Merit level in the Faculty of Education.

2.2.04 OBAFEMI AWOLowo UNIVERSITY, ILE-IFE

- (a) The University does not accept a pass in English Language for admission to any programme. However it accepts Teachers' Grade II (TC II) for B.A. Educ/B.Ed degree programmes only.
- (b) A pass in the General Paper at the Principal Level of the Higher School Certificate is regarded as equivalent to an Ordinary Level Credit pass in English Language.
- (c) **For Direct Entry:**
 - (i) OAU requires a minimum of three (3) 'A' Level Science subjects as indicated. ND/HND (Upper Credit) as indicated in appropriate cases for candidates seeking admissions into the Faculties of Environmental Design and Management, Health Science, Pharmacy and Technology.
 - (ii) For Admissions into the Faculty of Education, Two (2) Teaching subjects from Colleges of Education are required. The Faculty does not accept Guidance and Counselling as a Teaching subject.
 - (iii) NCE Holders from Colleges of Education, affiliated Colleges of Education and non affiliated ones will be admitted into Part II.

(iv) **FACULTY OF EDUCATION
UTME**

Five (5) Credits in General Certificate of Education or its equivalent from any nationally or internationally recognised examination body or TCII Credit/Merit passes, which must include English Language for all disciplines. In addition to this, a Credit pass in Mathematics is compulsory for all Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Education programmes.

The "Principle and Practice of Education" is now acceptable as one of the subjects for admission.

Other specific requirements for each programme are stated in the Faculties' table.

DIRECT ENTRY

In addition to 'O' Level requirements, candidates seeking Direct Entry admissions into the Faculty of Education shall possess GCE 'A' Level passes or NCE Credits/Merits in two (2) relevant teaching subjects or one professional/teaching subject offered as double major or one professional subject combined with a teaching subject (i.e. a course/subject offered as double major needs not be combined with any teaching subject). However, a candidate with a pass in one of the teaching subjects may be considered for admission provided the aggregate is not less than seven (7) points in all. Professional subjects that can be combined with teaching subjects for admissions include Primary Education Studies (PES), Guidance and Counselling, Computer Science/Studies and any Special Education specialization. Candidates holding NCE certificate in any vocational subject (offered as combined or as double major) e.g. Electrical Electronics, Auto Mechanics, Building Technology etc are eligible for admissions into the B.Ed. Mathematics/Integrated Science or Physics Education programmes. Candidates holding NCE certificates in any Business Studies, Home Economics are eligible for admissions into either B.Sc Education (Economics) or B.Ed Social Studies programmes. Candidates holding NCE certificates in any of Office Management, Secretarial Studies, Typing and Shorthand are eligible for admission into the B.Ed Social Studies programme. Candidates with Diploma in Education with a minimum of Merit pass from any recognised institution are eligible for Direct Entry admissions. Specific requirements for each course are stated in the Faculties' table.

2.2.05 UNIVERSITY OF NIGERIA, NSUKKA

(a) University of Nigeria, Nsukka requires all candidates applying for admissions into any of its programme to possess five (5) 'O' Level Credit passes which must include a Credit pass in English Language and a Science subject at not more than two (2) sittings. Entry requirements for Direct Entry must include UTME requirements for that particular programme. Prospective candidates should also visit its website: www.unn.edu.ng for updates on both University and Departmental Entry requirements.

2.2.06 COVENANT UNIVERSITY, OTTA, OGUN STATE

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

(i) Credit passes in the Senior Secondary Certificate (SSC), or its equivalent in relevant subjects in addition to acceptable score in the UTME, are the qualifications for admissions into the four (4)-year degree programmes of Covenant University.

(ii) Covenant University does not admit through Direct Entry.

(iii) English Language Requirement

In all cases, Credit passes in Mathematics and English Language at the Senior School Certificate (SSC) or equivalent are required for all programmes in Covenant University.

2.2.07 FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF AGRICULTURE, ABEOKUTA

Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta requires all candidates seeking admissions into any of its programmes to possess at least five (5) SSC credit passes in relevant subjects including English Language and Mathematics at not more than two (2) sittings.

The candidates must be sixteen (16) years of age by 1st of October in the year of admission.

Agricultural programmes

UTME:

Five (5) 'O' level credit passes in English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics and Biology at not more than two (2) sittings for admission into any course of the programme.

A waiver is given to candidates with pass in Biology if he/she has a credit pass in Agricultural Science. A pass in Physics is acceptable only for Agricultural programmes.

DIRECT ENTRY:

In addition to 'O' Level requirements, candidates seeking Direct Entry admissions shall posses GCE 'A' Level passes in Chemistry and one (1) of Biology, Agricultural Science, Physics, Mathematics or Geography.

Holders of ND/HND qualifications with at least Upper Credit in Agriculture or related disciplines may be considered for Direct Entry. The University accepts NCE with at least Credit in Agricultural Science.

Sciences and Engineering programmes

UTME:

Five (5) 'O' Level Credit passes in English Language, Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics and Biology at not more than two (2) sittings for admissions into any course of the programme.

DIRECT ENTRY:

In addition to 'O' Level requirements, candidates seeking Direct Entry admission shall possess GCE 'A' Level passes in any two of the following: Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Zoology/Botany OR ND (Upper Credit), NCE (Credit) in related areas from a recognised Institution.

NCE (Technical) is not acceptable for Engineering Programmes.

Holders of ND/HND qualifications with at least Upper Credit in Agriculture or related disciplines may be considered for Direct Entry. The University accepts NCE with at least Credit in Agricultural Science.

2.2.08 FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, AKURE

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- (a) Commencing from 2005/2006 academic session, all programmes offered in the University require a minimum of at least a Credit pass in English Language and Mathematics.
- (b) A pass in Physics is only acceptable in the following Departments:
 - (i) Estate Management,
 - (ii) Industrial Design,
 - (iii) Urban and Regional Planning,
 - (iv) Agricultural Economics & Extension,
 - (v) Eco-tourism and Wildlife Management,
 - (vi) Fisheries and Aquaculture Technology,
 - (vii) Crop Soil and Pest Management
- (c) A pass in Chemistry is only acceptable in Architecture

- (d) FUTA accepts a minimum of pass at Upper Credit Level of the National Diploma for Direct Entry candidates from NBTE accredited institutions.

2.2.09 EBONYI STATE UNIVERSITY, ABAKALIKI

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the various Departmental requirements, a candidate MUST have the University Minimum entry requirement of five (5) Credit passes in relevant subjects including English Language and Mathematics at GCE 'O' Level/SSC or equivalents.

2.2.10 SALEM UNIVERSITY, LOKOJA

Direct Entry Mode

- a) For candidates to qualify for direct entry into Salem University, they must have 'A' Level/IJMB passes in two (2) relevant subjects in addition to five (5) Credit passes at the 'O' level, which must include English Language and Mathematics. Candidates with good ND or NCE passes may also be considered for admission via direct entry.
- b) In addition to the above general requirements, prospective students must satisfy the specific College/Departmental requirements

2.2.11. CRESCENT UNIVERSITY, ABEOKUTA

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- (a) All applicants will be required to go through Crescent University's screening exercise without which a candidate will not be offered admission into the University.
- (b) Interested candidates who have applied to Joint Admissions and Matriculation Board (JAMB) for admission and wish to change their first choice to Crescent University are required to:

- (1) Apply for change of institution through JAMB
 - (2) Obtain the CRESCENT UNIVERSITY, ABEOKUTA application form
 - (3) Participate in the screening exercise
 - (4) All applicants are required to obtain JAMB forms as well as Crescent University online application forms before they can qualify for the screening exercise.
 - (5) Admission through JAMB will be offered to candidates who have taken Crescent University as their choice and have acceptable scores in the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME).
- (a) **DIRECT ENTRY NCE, ND, HND** in relevant fields and at least at lower Credit Level in addition to 'O' Level requirements stated above may be admitted at appropriate Level.
 - (b) Two (2) Advanced Level passes or its equivalent in relevant subjects in addition to 'O' Level requirements stated above.
 - (c) The IJMB at acceptable grade Levels.

2.2.12 FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, MINNA

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the various departmental requirements, a candidate MUST have SSC credit passes in Mathematics and English Language.

2.2.13 FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF PETROLEUM RESOURCES, EFFURUM

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- i. All admissions into FUPRE are through UTME
- ii. FUPRE will admit students via Direct Entry into 200 Level only through the JUPEB with effect from 2015/2016 session.
- iii. FUPRE requires all candidates applying for admission to possess a minimum of five (5) Credit passes in SSC/NABTEB/NECO etc in relevant subjects, including English Language and Mathematics at **not more than two (2)**

sittings. This is in addition to satisfying other specific College/Departmental requirements.

- iv. FUPRE accepts a credit pass in Agricultural Science in place of Biology for Mathematics and Computer Science programmes.
- v. A pass in Physics is acceptable for Environmental Management and Toxicology, if the student has a credit pass in Geography, Agricultural Science or any other relevant subject.
- vi. FUPRE requires all Engineering students admitted through Direct Entry to possess a minimum of three (3) 'A' Level passes in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics while those admitted into the Sciences are expected to possess a minimum of two (2) 'A' Level passes in subjects including Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology, depending on their course choice.
- vii. Prospective candidates may visit the University's website at www.fupre.edu.ng for updates on both University and Departmental entry requirements.

2.2.14 UNIVERSITY OF ABUJA

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Credit Level passes in English Language and Mathematics are required for admissions into all programmes. An ordinary pass in Mathematics may be accepted for LAW and all ARTS based programmes.

2.2.15 FEDERAL UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, OWERRI

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Credit Level passes in English Language, Mathematics and Chemistry are mandatory in addition to Credit passes in other subjects relevant to the respective Departments.

2.2.16 UNIVERSITY OF ILORIN

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

1. Admissions by Direct Entry

Candidates must possess one of the following qualifications:

- (i) A minimum of two (2) passes at 'A' Level. In addition, candidates must also obtain at least Credit passes in five (5) subjects at SSC or approved equivalent, including English Language and Mathematics at not more than two (2) sittings (See tables for other faculty requirements).
- (ii) A minimum of two (2) passes in recognised NCE subjects. Education is accepted as a second 'A' Level subject for those taking programmes in Education. In addition, candidates must also obtain at least Credit passes in five (5) subjects at SSC or approved equivalent, including English Language and Mathematics at not more than two (2) sittings. (See tables for other faculty requirements).
- (iii) Candidates who successfully pass the final examination of the following Institutions shall also be considered eligible for admission: The International Baccalaureate obtained from an accredited Institution with relevant gradings; National Diploma from Monotechnics/Polytechnics or Colleges of Technology, not below Upper Credit and applicable only to some faculties (See table on faculty requirements); and the Nigeria Defence Academy Certificate as moderated by a recognised University. In addition, candidates must also obtain at least credit passes in five (5) subjects at SSC or approved equivalent, including English Language and Mathematics at not more than two (2) sittings

Other conditions to note:

- (i) No subject may be counted at both 'O' and 'A' Levels.
- (ii) General Paper at HSC or in any other examination will not be accepted as a substitute for English language.
- (iii) Credit passes in English Language and Mathematics of the IJMB at the 'O' Level are acceptable as equivalent to SSC/GCE 'O' Level.

2.2.17 VERITAS UNIVERSITY, ABUJA

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- (i) A minimum standard of five (5) credit passes at not more than two (2) sittings, including English Language in all programmes. For all Science programmes, candidates must have credit passes in Physics, Chemistry and Biology. For Management and Social Sciences, candidates requires five (5) credit passes to include English and Mathematics. For programmes in Economics, candidates must have credit pass in Economics and for other Social Science programmes, e.g. Political Science/Sociology, candidates must have a pass in Mathematics.
- (ii) Grade II Teacher's Certificate (TC II) with Credit or Merit passes in at least five (5) subjects.
- (iii) NTC, NBC with credit passes in five (5) subjects relevant to the programme and obtained at not more than two (2) sittings. For the purpose of NTC/NBC, a credit pass in any General Education subjects, Trade related subjects and Trade component subjects is equivalent to a credit pass in a subject.

DIRECT ENTRY

Applicants with one (1) of the following qualifications may be considered for admission:

- i) A minimum of five (5) subjects passes at not more than two (2) sittings with at least two (2) at Advanced Level and the others, at credit level of the SSC/GCE 'O' Level, NTC/NBC. No subject shall be counted at both Ordinary and Advanced Levels.

- iii. Two (2) A' Level passes in the relevant subjects.

2.2.42 ONDO STATE UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY, OKITIPUPA

UTME

At least five (5) 'O' Level credit passes at one sitting including English Language and Mathematics.

All programmes are of five (5) years duration.

DIRECT ENTRY

At least two (2) 'A' Level passes in relevant science subjects in addition to UTME requirements.

In addition, candidates must satisfy the departmental requirements.

2.2.43 FEDERAL UNIVERSITY, OTUOKE, BAYELSA STATE

UTME

ARTS

Five (5) 'O' Level credit passes including English Language, Mathematics and any two (2) of Literature in English, Religious Studies and History or Government at not more than two (2) sittings.

SOCIAL SCIENCES

Five (5) 'O' Level credit passes including English Language, Mathematics and any two (2) of Accounting, Geography, Government and any other subject at not more than two (2) sittings.

MANAGEMENT SCIENCES (ADMINISTRATION)

Five (5) 'O' Level credit passes including English Language, Mathematics and any three (3) of Accounting, Business Studies, Commerce and Economics at not more than two (2) sittings.

ENGINEERING/ENVIRONMENTAL/TECHNOLOGY AND SCIENCES

Five (5) 'O' Level credit passes including English Language, Mathematics and any three (3) Science subjects at not more than two (2) sittings.

2.2.44 NIGERIAN DEFENCE ACADEMY, KADUNA, KADUNA STATE

REQUIREMENT FOR ADMISSIONS INTO THE REGULAR COURSE

- a. Minimum of five (5) 'O' Level credit passes including English Language and Mathematics or TC II obtained in subjects relevant to the programme of choice at not more than two (2) sittings.
 - b. Candidates must be between seventeen (17) and twenty-one (21) years old at the time of entry into the Academy. Note that Nigerian Air force candidates must be between seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) years old at entry.
 - c. Candidates must be medically and physically fit and must be of good moral character.
 - d. Candidates must be single male or female without legal obligation to support any child or other individuals.
 - e. Present a Certificate of Origin obtained from a Local Government and a Certificate of State Indigene ship from the Office of the State Governor.
1. Furthermore, candidates are to note the following:
 - a. Awaiting results are not qualified. Results not submitted with application forms will not be accepted.
 - b. Only examination results of not more than five (5) years from date of application will be accepted.

Five (5) 'O' Level credit passes including English Language and Mathematics or its equivalent at not more than two (2) sittings.

DIRECT ENTRY

Two (2) passes at 'A' Level and three (3) credit passes at 'O' Level including English Language provided the subjects at both levels are not counted twice.

- i) At least NCE merit passes in the two (2) major teaching subjects with credit passes in three (3) other subjects at the 'O' Level or its equivalent, including English Language and Mathematics. Education shall be counted as a subject required for matriculation in case of candidates applying for admissions into the Faculty of Education only.
- ii) ND with a minimum of Upper credit in the relevant programmes from recognised institutions may be considered for Direct Entry into the appropriate Departments/Faculties provided the minimum matriculation requirements of the University are satisfied.

Note:

- a) A pass in General Paper in the HSC is not acceptable as equivalent to 'O' Level credit pass in English Language.
- b) TC II Arithmetic process is not acceptable as equivalent to 'O' Level credit pass in Mathematics.
- c) A pass in NCE General English may be acceptable as an equivalent of 'O' Level credit pass in English Language.
- d) A pass in NCE Basic Mathematics may be acceptable as an equivalent of 'O' Level credit pass in Mathematics

2.2.46 FEDERAL UNIVERSITY, LAFIA

Five (5) 'O' Level credit passes including English Language and Mathematics at not more than two (2) sittings.

2.2.47 UNIVERSITY OF JOS, JOS

UTME

- i. Credit passes in five (5) subjects at 'O' Level or its equivalents including English Language and other departmental requirements as stated in the relevant sections of this brochure at not more than two (2) sittings.

DIRECT ENTRY

- i. GCE 'A' Level, IJMB, HSC with at least two (2) passes in principal subjects.
- ii. ND/HND at credit level obtained from institutions recognized by the University of Jos
- iii. NCE for programmes in Education at credit/merit level. NCE pass in Language and Communication skills is accepted as equivalent to 'O' Level credit pass in English Language for Education programmes only.
- iv. IJMB 'O' Level pass in English Language is accepted as equivalent to 'O' Level credit pass in English Language provided the candidate applied for Direct Entry using IJMB result only.

2.2.48 St. AUGUSTINE UNIVERSITY, ILARA

Prospective candidates seeking admissions into the University must not be less than 16 years of age and would need to satisfy the following general requirements before they are offered admissions into the University:

- a. All admissions into the University shall be through the Joint Admissions and Matriculations Board (JAMB)
- b. For admissions into 100 level (UTME), candidates must:

- Obtain a minimum of five (5) Ordinary Level credit passes at SSCE (or its equivalent) in relevant subjects including English and other relevant subjects at not more than 2 sittings;
 - Note that a credit pass in Mathematics is compulsory for all Science, Social and Management Science programmes;
 - Credit pass in English language and any four (4) subjects is acceptable for Philosophy programme
 - Also pass the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) as specified by JAMB in relevant subjects and satisfy the University requirements in a Post-UTME screening exercise for the Course of study.
- c. For admission to 200 level (direct entry), candidates should (in addition to five (5) SSC credit passes stated above, obtain at least two (2) 'A' Level (or its equivalent) full passes in relevant subjects, or possess ND/NCE, or possess a good first degree in another field as the case may be.
- d. Depending on each programme, degree holders and Higher National Diploma (HND) holders from recognized universities and polytechnics may be admitted into relevant programmes at 300 level to pursue a degree course.
- e. All candidates seeking admissions into the University must meet the SSCE basic requirements.

2.2.50 GODFREY OKOYE UNIVERSITY, ENUGU

Admissions Requirements

Candidates should have a minimum of five (5) 'O' Level credit passes at not more than two (2) sittings, including English Language and subjects relevant to the courses of study.

The University does not accept a pass in English Language for admissions into any programme. However, it accepts a pass in Mathematics for the following programmes in the Faculty of Arts: English and Literary Studies, History, International Studies and Diplomacy, Music, Philosophy, Religious Studies, French and Igbo. A pass in Mathematics is acceptable for the following programmes in the Faculty of Education: English and Literary

Studies, History, International Studies and Diplomacy, Political Science Education and Social Studies Education.

A pass in Mathematics is acceptable for the following programmes in the Faculty of Management and Social Sciences: International Relations, Mass Communication and Sociology. The Senate of the University allows a candidate without a credit pass in only one required subject to re-sit the subject and submit the result within the year of admission.

DIRECT ENTRY

In addition to having five (5) credit passes in SSC or its equivalent at not more than two (2) sittings, candidates must possess at least two (2) 'A' Level passes in subjects relevant to the desired programme. Holders of ND/NCE qualifications, with at least Upper Credit or a CGPA of 2.5 and above may be considered. Otherwise the candidate is admitted into 100 level. HND holders with Upper Credit may be considered for 300 level. Holders of JUPEB qualifications, with a minimum of 50% score from the cumulative of 'O' Level result (60%) and JUPEB result (40%), are admitted into 200 level, otherwise the candidates are admitted into 100 level. NCE holders from the School of Ecumenical Education with CGPA of 2.5 and above are admitted into 300 level of the Faculty of Education, provided the UTME requirements are met.

Note: Candidates awaiting results of any relevant examination may also apply. They should however note that processing of application will not be completed until entry requirements are met.

2.2.51 EDO UNIVERSITY IYAMHO, EDO STATE

UTME

Candidates must attain the required standard in JAMB UTME in addition to the various departmental minimum entry requirements of five (5) credit passes in relevant subjects including English Language and Mathematics at SSC or its equivalent at not more than two (2) sittings except Medicine and Surgery which is one (1) sitting only.

DIRECT ENTRY

- i. A minimum of merit pass in NCE, credit in OND/HND, 2nd Class Lower grade in a University degree for admission into a 4 and 5 years Bsc., B.MLS. MBBS. B.NSc, B.Eng in addition to the 'O' level requirements.
- ii. Candidates with two (2) 'A' level passes or its equivalent in relevant subjects in addition to 'O' level requirement stated above.
- iii. IJMB/JUPEB are also acceptable for admissions into Degree programmes.
