## DEPARTMENT AND PROGRAMMES

### 1. ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TECHNOLOGY (HND)

This programme leads to the award of higher national diploma (HND) in environmental Health Technology of the West African Health Examination Board (WAHEB).

**QUALIFICATION:** Prospective Candidate must possess

- a. National Diploma in Environmental Health Technology
- b. Note candidate with awaiting result can apply but admission will be offered upon the provision of the National Diploma result.

**Duration:** Two Academic Sessions

### 2. ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH TECHNOLOGY (EHT)

This programme leads to the award of National Diploma (ND) in West African Health Examination Board (WAHEB).

**QUALIFICATION:** Prospective Candidate must possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes at not more than two (2) sittings in WAEC, SSCE, NECO, NABTEB and GCE this must include:

- a. English language
- b. Mathematics
- c. Biology or health science
- d. Chemistry
- e. Physics

**Duration:** Two Academic Sessions

### 3. COMMUNITY HEALTH EXTENSION WORKERS (CHEW)

This programme leads to the award of National Diploma (ND) in Community Health Extension Workers by the Community Health registration Board of Nigeria.

**QUALIFICATION:** Prospective Candidate must Possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes at not more than two (2) sitting in WAEC, SSCE, NECO, NABTEB and GCE this must include:

1. A licensed JCHEW certificate holder with basic academic qualification must possess credit pass in:
  - a. English language
  - b. Mathematics

- c. Biology
- d. Chemistry
- e. Physics

2. A candidate must possess five (5) credit pass in:

- a. English language
- b. Mathematics
- c. Biology
- d. Chemistry
- e. Physics

**Duration:** Three (3) Academic Sessions

### 4. JUNIOR COMMUNITY HEALTH EXTENSION WORKERS (JCHEW)

This programme leads to the award of certificate in Junior Community Health Extension Workers by the Community Health Registration Board of Nigeria.

**Qualification:** prospective candidate must possess a minimum of three (3) credit passes at not more than two (2) sitting in WAEC, SSCE, NECO, NABTEB and GCE this must include:

- a. English language
- b. Mathematics
- c. Biology and passes in any two (2) subject

**DURATION:** two (2) academic sessions

### 5. MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIAN (MLT)

This programme leads to the award of medical laboratory technicians certificate by the Medical Laboratory Science Council of Nigeria.

**QUALIFICATION:** Prospective Candidate must Possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes at not more than two (2) sitting in WAEC, SSCE, NECO, NABTEB and GCE this must include:

- a. English language
- b. Mathematics
- c. Biology
- d. Chemistry
- e. Physics

**NB:** Result should not be more than ten (10) years at the point of admission

**Duration:** three (3) academic sessions

### 6. HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT TECHNOLOGY (HND) HIMT

This programme leads to the award of Higher National Diploma Health Information Management by the Health Records Officers Board of Nigeria.

**QUALIFICATION:** Prospective Candidate must possess

- a. National Diploma (ND) or Professional Diploma (PD) in Health Information Management.
- b. English language
- c. Mathematics
- d. Biology
- e. Chemistry
- f. Physics

**Duration:** two (2) academic sessions

### 7. HEALTH INFORMATION MANAGEMENT TECHNOLOGY (HIMT)

This programme leads to the award of National Diploma in Health Information Management by the Health Records Officers Board of Nigeria.

**QUALIFICATION:** prospective Candidate must possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes at not more than two (2) sittings in WAEC, SSCE, NECO, NABTEB and GCE this must include:

- a. English language
- b. Mathematics
- c. Chemistry
- d. Biology
- e. Physics

**Duration:** Two (2) Academic Sessions

### 1. MEDICAL SOCIAL WORKERS (ND) NATIONAL

This programme leads to the award of National Diploma (ND)

**QUALIFICATION:** Prospective Candidate must possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes at not more than two (2) sittings in WAEC, SSCE, NECO and GCE this must include:

- a. English language
- b. Government
- c. Civic education and three others from the following: Literature in English, Christian Religious Knowledge, Commerce, Economics, Geography and History.

**Duration:** Two (2) Academic Sessions

### 8. DENTAL SURGERY TECHNICIAN (DST)

This programme leads to the awards of National Diploma (ND) in Dental Surgery Technicians.

**QUALIFICATION:** Prospective Candidate must possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes at not more than two (2) sittings in WAEC, SSCE, NECO and GCE this must include:

- a. English language
- b. Mathematics
- c. Biology
- d. and any other two (2) subject

**DURATION:** Three (3) Academic Sessions.

### 9. PHARMACY TECHNICIANS STUDIES (PTS)

This programme leads to the award of Certified Pharmacy Technician Certificate by the Pharmacist Council of Nigeria.

**QUALIFICATION:** Prospective Candidate must possess a minimum of five (5) credit passes at not more than two (2) sittings in WAEC, SSCE, NECO, and GCE this must include:

- e. Physics
